Villagers buy their own pub - now all they need is a Tenant!!

A call went out this week for an experienced Tenant to run a famous Oxfordshire pub - after villagers clubbed together to buy it.

The Seven Stars nestles in one of the country's oldest and largest village greens, at the heart of Marsh Baldon, which is mentioned in the Domesday Book.

Just a few months ago this historic hostelry faced closure. So the community decided to save it. The Baldons and Nuneham Community Society Limited was formed and villagers have almost reached their fund-raising target to buy the pub. Now they want someone to run it.

Phil Collins of the Society's management committee said: "We don't want to run the pub ourselves. We recognise that takes time and expertise that we don't have. We want to lease it to a professional, to run it themselves, as a thriving business.

“The Stars has been successful in the past and we are sure it can be in the future. We have looked closely at the figures and believe it has great potential. The pub has great support in the village and also have a lot of potential lunchtime trade from businesses nearby like the Science Park and Oxford city is on our doorstep.”

The pub will carry an attractive rent and has 3 bedroom accommodation above.
